After the success of the Fall Barn Tour, everyone is looking forward to being "on the road again" for our annual Spring Conference and Barn Tour, to be held at MSU on March 7-8, 2014. In conjunction with the conference, this year's barn tour will take place on Friday, March 7th, with the buses loading at 8:00 a.m. and departing promptly at 8:30

a.m. This year's conference barn tour will be a focused look at two unique facilities in Oakland County—Oakland County Parks' Ellis Barn, built in 1885 and relocated and restored as a significant park center in 2004/5; and the Van Hoosen Barn at the Rochester Hills Museum. Jon Noyes of the Parks and Patrick McKay from Rochester

Hills Museum are planning for programs, tours and lunch on-site at these two significant venues. Presentations and videos in-route (on the bus) will provide context and information on the organizations and their preservation efforts. Assisting in the production are the Oakland County Historical Commission and a new volunteer group, the Oakland County History Corps. The tour will depart from and return to the MBPN Conference headquarters.

The conference sessions will be held at the Kellogg Center, MSU, in East Lansing. See over for the schedule of Saturday presentations and sessions. A gala Awards Banquet will once again be offered on Friday evening, March 7th, and the 2014 Barn of the Year Awards will be presented. We hope to see you for the conference and tour!
